- For each full credit a student can have an off 1st or 4th block. Please indicate on your registration form which block you want off.

New Courses for 12th Graders

Law and Society

A one-credit course designed to acquaint students with the basic legal principles common to business and personal activities. This course is an overview of criminal, civil, contract, and consumer law.

Digital Video Game Development

A one-credit course designed to provide students with experiences and instruction in applying the fundamental skills and techniques in game development. Designed to introduce the elements and structure of game programming and design.

Banking and Financial Services/ Financial Management

A one-credit course designed to help students develop skills related to banking and related services. These are the two courses in the Finance Academy. You must register for both and commit to a year long during 3rd block.

New Courses for 12th Graders

Advanced Manufacturing and Machinery

Advanced Manufacturing and Machining is an honors-level course offered to juniors and seniors interested in earning the certifications that will cover manufacturing safety, machine maintenance, manufacturing processes and production, quality control, supply chain logistics, and material handling

Super Seminar

This year long class will consist of AP English Literature, AP Government, and AP Comparative Government. It will be one block per day, both semesters. Students will receive 3 AP credits upon completion of the course. The class will be taught by 2 AP trained instructors. You will be required to sit for 3 AP exams.
