May Challenge:

Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: Phoneme segmentation and blending

Phonics: applying digraph /th/ voiced (this) and unvoiced (path) to reading and writing words

Sight Words: Review all kindergarten high frequency words

Vocabulary Words: distant, spell, hide, funny, attack

Comprehension: Compare and Contrast; Text features- stanzas

Math:

We will spend class time practicing addition facts, subtraction facts, and word problems. We will also continue to practice using: positional words (above, below, in front of, behind, beside), comparing 2D shapes (circle, triangle, square, rectangle, and hexagon), and 3D shapes (sphere, cone, cube, cylinder).

Please decide what to work on at home with your child based on your child's Progress Report.

Important Information

We will be taking our DIBELS benchmark tests on May 8th & 9th. We have also been assessing for the 4th 9 weeks Report Cards. This is one reason why this month's challenge is so important.
