April Challenge:



Listen to your child read 10 minutes a day and keep reading to them for 20 minutes a day.

Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: segmenting four phoneme words like desk, stop, and black

Phonics: long vowel o_e like in home and poke and long vowel e_e like in Pete

Sight Words: play, look, and see

Vocabulary Words: qualities, military, president, leader, defend, oval, private, improve, choose, and work

Comprehension: Ask and answer questions about key details (cause and effect) in text

Big Ideas Chapter 12

This week we will wrap up our instruction on 2D and 3D shapes. We will review all of our 2D shapes: circle, square, triangle, rectangle, hexagon. We will also review our 3D shapes: sphere, cube, cone, cylinder. We will practice comparing and differentiating between 2D and 3D shapes.
