April Challenge:



Listen to your child read 10 minutes a day and keep reading to them for 20 minutes a day.

Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: phoneme segmentation and identifying beginning and ending sounds in words

Phonics: reviewing short vowel u and using -ck to spell the final /k/ sound in words

Sight Words: how, now, and down

Vocabulary Words: any, break, declare, exclaim, fuss, judge, mind, such

Comprehension: Identify and describe main story elements including characters and setting

We will continue to focus on 2D shapes. We are learning to identify and draw: circle, square, rectangle, triangle, and hexagon. We will also learn how to compare shapes.
