Reading: Wonders Unit 1 Week 2

Phonological Awareness Skill: Blending syllables to make words

Phonics: Identifying the letter Aa, producing and applying the short /a/ sound (as in “apple”)

Sight Word: I, we

Vocabulary Words: adventure, arrived, exciting, exhausted, movement

Comprehension: Ask and answer questions; identifying key details

Math: Big Ideas: Review Chapters 1-4

We are reviewing:

1. Moving one object at a time while counting.
2. Saying one number name for each object counted.
3. Knowing the amount stays even when the objects are rearranged.
4. Comparing numerals and sets of objects using the vocabulary: greater than, less than, and equal to.

Important Information

Practice sheets come home each Monday. Please work on the activities throughout the week and return the following Monday. Have your child complete the work in pencil. Be sure to record the score of letter naming. This should be done on 2 different days. Also note on the top of the backside, your child is asked to count daily.
