CORE MATH - PAST PRECALCULUS



Calculus A honors/PreAP + Calculus AB, AP

This is a yearlong course. Calculus A is taken in the fall and Calculus AB is taken in the spring leading up to the AP test in May. It covers Calculus 1 material.



Calculus A honors/PreAP. + Calculus BC, AP

This is a yearlong course. Calculus A is taken in the fall and BC is taken in the spring. It covers a few more units than AB because it covers Calculus 1 & 2 material.

Students may enroll in 1 or 2 consecutive blocks of Co-op.


Each Co-Op Block requires 8 hours a week of work for total of 140 hours a Semester (240 Hours for 2 Classes)

Students must have earned a College Career Readiness Indicator (CCRI) in order to be eligible for Co-op. (There are exceptions)

Students must have reliable transportation and be off campus during their Co-op blocks.


