\$75 per half credit (MCS Students)  
\$150 per credit (MCS Students)  
\$100 per half credit (Out-of-District Students)  
\$175 per credit (Out-of-District Students)

Registration will begin on May 1. Registration will be online and links will be publicized on each school's website. Anyone who cannot register online may visit the school's front desk beginning on May 1st.

The core courses will be offered as Credit Recovery options, unless the student does not qualify for Credit Recovery and needs to retake the entire course.

The following ACCESS courses will be available as Academic Opportunities. Course credits are noted in parentheses:

**Career Preparedness:** Career Preparedness (1.0),  
Career Preparedness A (0.5), Career Preparedness B (0.5)

**Career Technical Education:** Accounting (1.0),  
Business Software Applications I (1.0), Entrepreneurship (1.0),  
Intro to Digital Literacy & Computer Science (1.0),  
Medical Terminology (1.0), Personal Finance (0.5)

**Electives:** Creative Writing (1.0), Psychology (0.5), Sociology (0.5)

**Health & Physical Education:** Beginning Kinesiology (1.0),  
Health (0.5)

**Social Studies:** Economics (0.5), US Government (0.5)

All courses, with the exception of Driver's Ed, will be taken through ACCESS Virtual Learning, an online platform. **No refunds will be issued for any classes that a student registers for. Students will need to report to the campus in person to take their tests, and to meet certain requirements of specific courses (Beginning Kinesiology, Health).**

The last day to drop any summer school class without a grade posting to the student's transcript is June 8th, by the close of business. If a class is dropped on or before June 8th, no refund will be provided, but the grade will not post to the student's transcript. **All other grades will post to the student's transcript at the end of the summer school program, regardless of student progress.**

## Driver's Education Sessions

There will be 3 sessions of Driver's Education. **The fee for the summer Driver's Education course is \$150.00.** Driver's Ed registration begins May 1 for MCS Students and May 8 for Out-of-District Students.
