 - 4) ***Two Letters of Recommendation***

Scholarship Policies and Procedures

1. Ten scholarships will be awarded to qualified applicants. These scholarships will be known as the Huntsville Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie and Auxiliary #3263 Scholarships.
2. This scholarship will be for \$1,000 for one year. The scholarship must be used within one year from the date of the award, unless Huntsville Aerie or Auxiliary #3263 is notified in writing stating the reason an extension is requested.
3. This scholarship is available for use at any accredited college or trade school for undergraduate and graduate courses. The scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college of the recipient's choice. This scholarship can be used for school tuition, materials, or housing expenses at the direction of the recipient. It will be the responsibility of the recipient to provide the Aerie with the necessary proof of enrollment and the correct address of the school for the dispersal of funds. Unused funds (due to the recipient's withdrawal or expulsion from the school) will be refunded to the Aerie and Auxiliary Scholarship Fund by the college or trade school to which the funds were issued.
4. **Each applicant must include the following:**
 1. **A completed application form.**
 2. **A personal Essay with a minimum of two hundred words. (The essay should explain his/her needs and future goals).**
 3. **A transcript of the applicant's most recent grades.**
 4. **Two letters of personal recommendation. (Letters of recommendation should reflect the candidate's leadership ability, potential and sincerity).**
5. All applications must be in the hands of the Scholarship Committee by the date determined by the Scholarship Chairperson. The chairperson will notify each winning applicant in writing as to the action of the committee. The winning recipient's school will also be notified of the committee's actions
6. Each applicant must present him/herself for a personal interview with the scholarship committee if requested to do so.
7. Scholarship selection will be scored on the following criteria:
 - > Transcript of grades and test scores
 - > Essay
 - > Potential leadership ability as demonstrated by involvement in school activities, employment, community work, church and service organizations.
 - > Need for assistance
8. The winners will be selected by the above criteria only.
9. The decision of the scholarship committee is final and binding.
