COLLEGE & CAREER READINESS (CCR) INDICATOR – MADISON CITY SCHOOLS

In November 2022, the Alabama State Board of Education amended the Alabama Administrative Code, Rule No. 290-3-1.02, which added a College and Career Readiness (CCR) Indicator to the Alabama High School Graduation Requirements.

Students graduating in the class of 2026 and beyond must achieve one of the below CCR Indicators to meet graduation requirements.

- 1. Earn a benchmark score in ANY subject area on the ACT® College Entrance Exam.**
 - English subtest: 18+
 - Reading subtest: 22+
 - Math subtest: 22+
 - Science subtest: 23+
- 2. Earn a qualifying score of three or higher on an Advanced Placement® Exam.**
- 3. Earn a qualifying score of four or higher on an International Baccalaureate® Exam.**
- 4. Earn college credit while in high school.**
- 5. Earn a silver or gold level on the ACT® WorkKeys® Exam.**
 - Minimum score of 4 on EACH of the three subtests:
 - Applied Math
 - Graphic Literacy
 - Workplace Documents
- 6. Complete an in-school youth apprenticeship program.**
- 7. Earn a career technical industry credential listed on the compendium of valuable credentials of the Alabama Committee on Credentialing and Career Pathways.**
- 8. Military enlistment.**
- 9. Attain Career and Technical Education (CTE) completer status.**
 - Earn three (3.0) credits with the grade of “C” or higher in CTE courses that are part of an approved CTE program of study, including the following requirements:
 - Earn a maximum of 1.0 credit in an approved CTE Program Foundation course.
 - Earn a minimum of 1.0 credit in an approved CTE Program Concentrator course.
 - Earn a 1.0 additional credit in an approved CTE Program Concentrator course OR in an approved CTE Program Capstone course.
 - Earn a “C” or higher in all three courses.
- 10. Any additional College and Career Readiness (CCR) indicator approved by the Alabama State Board of Education**
